

With the blessing of Msgr. Patrick, we will be changing the 9:30 Mass time to 9:00 am on Sunday beginning September 11<sup>th</sup> to allow time for Catechesis (Elementary -- High School Christian formation). The sessions would be approximately from 10:00 - 11:15 am for grades K-5, 6-8, 9-12, twice a month. We also are offering adult formation for all parents whose children are involved in family formation and possibly opening it up to all adults who are interested in participating. These sessions will take place in the Fellowship Hall.

The main reason for this change is as follows: The hybrid model for Christian Formation that we did this past year created a conflict for some liturgical ministers to participate in the 11:30 Masses. There was also the concern about families not attending Mass at all because they had to make a choice between Catechesis and the 11:30 Mass.

Obviously we don't have control over a family's decision, but we can offer them better opportunities to participate in all events the church offers, especially while they are here on Sundays.

Currently there is plenty of time between the end of 7:30 Mass (@8:20) to prepare for a 9:00 am Mass without parking lot or Fellowship Hall issues. We understand that change in scheduling is always difficult, but we feel that it would offer the best benefit to our parishioners.

**Confirmation 2023 starts soon! Are you ready?**

**Confirmation Orientation:** August 21st, after the 9:30 am mass

**Confirmation Retreat:** October 30th, 8:30-6:30 pm

Do you have a 10th grader or older student ready to be filled with the Holy Spirit?

**Confirmation Prep:** Students should register and regularly attend Faith Formation Sunday Gatherings, see above for registration. Attend Orientation, Retreat, Fall Confirmation Prep, February Confirmation Prep & Rehearsal. Students should also choose a confirmed Catholic sponsor (not a parent) to mentor them.

Confirmation year is a special time of formation where teens are brought further in their journey of knowing the love of Jesus.
