PARKING LOT RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT FAQ

Will there be islands around the parking lot light poles where tree and shrubs will be planted?

The master plan for the parking lot has islands for planting a tree and shrubs around the parking lot light poles. The islands will be installed at a later date after the Parking Lot Reconstruction Project is completed.

During the planning of reconstruction of the parking lot, the major concern was to have a construction plan that would not interfere with parking for the weekend masses.

The plan for the first week of construction is to have the asphalt removed, the dirt floor graded, and crusher stone put down by Friday afternoon. Parishioners will be able to park in the main parking lot for the weekend masses.

The installation of the concrete curb and gutters would have added two days to the project, and we would not be able to have the parking lot open for the weekend masses.

There is a depressed ditch across the entrance, when you come into the Electric Road entrance and take the first right to the main parking lot, will that be fixed with the Parking Lot Project?

Yes, the depressed ditch is included in the Parking Lot Reconstruction Project and will be fixed.
